

# Summer Worship Fellowship

(Role Name: Summer Worship Leader)

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## Summary of the Role

The Summer Worship Leader will be responsible for leading and overseeing all aspects of the corporate worship music ministry at Columbia Grove Covenant Church. This includes planning, developing, and leading meaningful and engaging musical worship experiences that align with the church's theology, mission, and vision, fostering a vibrant and authentic atmosphere of worship and encounter with God.

*June 6 - August 16, 2026 - This is a temporary position to provide musical leadership coverage while a pastor is on sabbatical.*

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## Key Responsibilities

### 1. Worship Service Leadership & Planning

- **Lead Worship:** Serve as a song leader for weekly services.
- **Service Design:** Collaborate with the preacher for that week to plan and structure worship services, ensuring musical and thematic alignment with the sermon series.
- **Musical Direction:** Select songs that are theologically sound, stylistically appropriate for a multigenerational context, and conducive to congregational singing.
- **Rehearsals:** Plan and lead weekly rehearsals, focusing on musical competence, spiritual preparation, and team unity.

### 2. Team Leadership & Administration

- **Scheduling:** Manage the scheduling and communication for all worship team volunteers using Fluro.

- **Cooperation:** Works with the Media Director to ensure that the required equipment is functioning and song lyrics are entered correctly.
  - **Preparation:** Ensure all resources needed by the worship team are in place for rehearsals so rehearsal time can be used for musical and team development, rather than preparing song charts or resolving technical challenges.
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## Qualifications and Skills

### Education and Experience

- A bachelor's degree in Music, Worship Arts, Theology, or a related field is preferred.

### Musical and Technical Proficiency

- Strong vocal and instrumental (guitar or keys preferred) abilities, with demonstrated capacity to lead both vocally and instrumentally.
- Proficiency in basic music theory and charting.
- Strong understanding of sound engineering, lighting, and presentation software (e.g., ProPresenter).

### Spiritual and Personal Characteristics

- A committed follower of Jesus Christ whose life reflects biblical principles.
- Agreement with the [beliefs and theological distinctives](#) of the [Evangelical Covenant Church](#).
- A collaborative team player with strong interpersonal skills and a desire to build up and empower volunteers.
- A proven ability to lead worship in a way that is sensitive to the Holy Spirit and encourages authentic congregational participation.
- Abide by the "[Columbia Grove Staff Handbook](#)."

This role trains under the Senior Pastor and reports to the Pastor of Congregational Care while the Senior Pastor is on sabbatical.

1. A cover letter detailing their personal faith journey and calling to worship ministry.
2. A professional resume.
3. Links to at least **three recent videos** of the candidate leading congregational worship.
