



Minister of Worship and Arts

The goal of the worship ministry at First Covenant Church is to glorify and magnify God by developing worshippers who will worship God in spirit and in truth (John 4:23).

MINISTRY PRIORITIES

Pastoral focus:

- Weekly craft large group worship gathering in communication/collaboration with and under the direction of the lead Pastor.
- Create, plan for, lead, implement programmatic elements - engaging the church body in the Sunday morning worship experience and special worship gatherings (Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, Christmas Eve, etc.)
- Seek to grow participation in Worship and Arts ministry by providing mentorship, coordination, leadership to variety of participants: musicians, vocalists, sound/graphics/computer technicians, artists as they use their gifts to honor God and edify people.

Operational focus:

- Create opportunities for members to use and express their gifts in worship/gatherings.
- Provide coordination, leadership, work to develop growing participation across the ages.
- Work in conjunction with the larger ministry staff and church body to develop a worshipping community that invites and connects all ages.

Administrative focus:

- In partnership with the Worship and Arts council member provide administrative oversight: Worship/arts budget, music archive, resource/equipment – care/upkeep/security.

- Maintain appropriate music licensure: CCLI, Media/tech/computer.
- Prepare and distribute worship and arts participant schedule, plan for worship team rehearsals, seasonal media/art, sanctuary aesthetics, etc.

Qualifications:

- Growing faith in Christ and a maturing spiritual life that pursues a God-honoring life-style.
- Musically qualified with a broad knowledge of worship music.
- Able to organize and lead rehearsals/guide musicians in creating music.
- Working knowledge of live sound system (digital mixing console) and audio visual presentation (ex: Pro-Presenter) .
- Ability to coordinate, plan, work with various teams and age groups.
- Passion to lead others in worship.
- Compatibility and support of the Evangelical Covenant Church and willingness to abide by the 'Ethical Principles for Covenant Ministers' (See...
